According to the gold plaque on the church floor he was born in 1848, although other sources state his date of birth as either 1849 or 1850.

8. How old is the Sacred Heart church? 134yrs

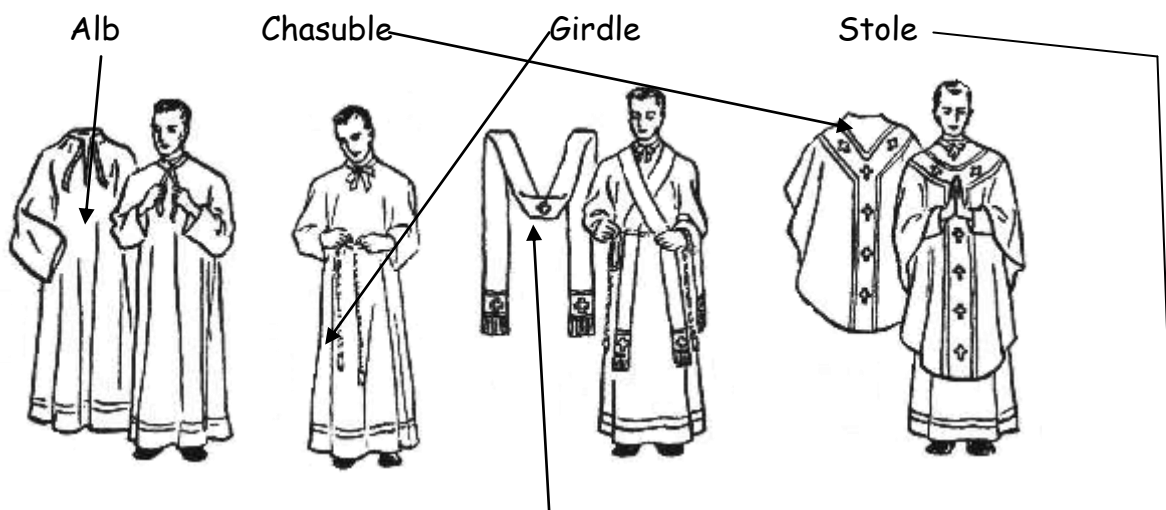
9. How many stations of the cross are shown in the church? 14

Find the 14th station. What part of the story does this tell?

Jesus is laid in the tomb.

10. Vestments are the robes worn by the priest. Draw a line from the picture to the matching garment.

(Clue: Alb - a long white robe, Girdle - ties alb at waist, Stole - a long, scarf-like vestment worn over the alb and under the chasuble, Chasuble - a long, sleeveless poncho-like garment worn over the alb and stole)



11. What time of the year does the priest wear purple?

Leading up to Christmas (during Advent) & Easter (during Lent).
