My Body and Blood for You

We admire great men and women who dedicate their lives to the good of others and were even willing to die for them. This is precisely what we celebrate whenever we come together for the Eucharist. We celebrate Jesus' life and death for us, but also his resurrection, for he is alive here among us, in his Church, in our world. In this Eucharist he gives us this disposition.
