## FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2014

If your child will be in year 3 or above by 1st Sept 2013, then he or she can make their First Reconciliation and Holy Communion in 2014. This year the programme for the children begins on Friday 6th December at 7 pm in the Cent Hall and it will culminate on the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) on Sunday 19th June 2014 (*presentation of First Communion Certificates*). First Holy Communion day itself will be celebrated in two groups on the 14th June, at 10.30am and at 1.30pm. There will be three compulsory monthly meetings for the Catholic Parent on September 26th, October 24th & November 28th at 8 pm, to help you in your role as teachers of the faith, a condition of Baptism that you agreed to when your child was Christened.

A register of attendance will be taken. Failure to attend all three meetings will result in your child's name being eliminated from the programme for this year, without refund. Please complete the form which is in the porch today and also available for download from the website and return to the parish office by 30/09/13 with a cheque (payable to The Sacred Heart Parish) or cash for £20 which will be your contribution towards the cost of the materials needed throughout the preparation and the flowers for First Communion Day. ## Action Alert from Society for the Protection of Unborn Children - Attack on Marriage

In the past fortnight, the government has widened its attack on marriage. Government Minister Baroness Stowell speaking in Parliament, made the astonishing claim that in law:

*"marriage does not require the fidelity of couples. It is open to each couple to decide for themselves on the importance of fidelity within their own relationship."*

This is not the correct statement of the law. The promise of fidelity are at the heart of marriage as a sacrament and as the foundation of families and society. The government statement suggests wider moves to undermine lasting faithful marriages. The House of Lords will vote on amendments to the bill on **8th** and **10th** July. Please write to members of the House of Lords asking them to uphold real marriage. The House of Commons will have a final debate on the bill around the 16th July. Please write to your MP urging him to uphold marriage, the union of a man and a woman. This will be your last chance to influence the passage of this damaging bill.
