Advent

Advent, which we begin today, is a time of preparation, a time of awaiting, a getting ready for the hoped-for-but-unexpected breaking through of the divine into this world. The story that we retell in the course of each year of Emmanuel, God-with-us; of his saving and reconciling acts, his birth and life, his teaching and his miracles, his passion, death and resurrection, is about to begin again. Advent is the introduction. "Listen to me... listen to me," says God through Isaiah. "This is who I am, this is my story. This is who you are. This is our story. Look beyond your present troubles, raise your eyes and hearts to heaven, believe that I, your God, will come in justice and power to restore and renew."
