Many thanks to those who gave up their time on Friday and Saturday to clean up to St Thomas Whyteleafe Church ready for the launch of our food bank in mid November. Sacred Heart has taken the decision to operate its own food bank and we are no longer part of the Trussell Trust venture. This decision was taken amicably and simply reflects a difference in vision regarding the project. Our food bank will open on a Friday, between 11am and 2pm and we will offer tea and coffee to those who attend. A development team has been appointed following the meeting last Friday evening and we are now implementing a voucher system. Doctors, schools and agencies like the CAB will dispense vouchers to those who need crisis food, and we will distribute this when the vouchers are handed in at the food bank. We need you to bring in food URGENTLY as outlined above. There is a large plastic bin clearly marked in the porch to put your items into. Many thanks for your generosity.

The Club will no longer open on Sundays.

The Club will re-open on Friday 1st November to members only. All members are to sign in on entry. Non members will be charged £3 for the first two visits after which they will be expected to become members.

All Primary School Children are to vacate the premises by 9.30 pm . Any found loitering in the premises after 9.30 pm will result in their parents' membership being cancelled! No excuses! No exceptions! No one UNDER THE AGE OF 18 are to approach the Bar for alcohol. You may be asked at any time to produce age verification by the Staff.

Since it is a Church run Club, Staff members are asked to serve the alcohol responsibly and refuse when necessary. We are in the public eye and do not wish to cause scandal by members being seen leaving the premises in a drunken stupor. Any abusive behaviour or language to other Club members or to the Staff will incur cancellation of membership and a permanent ban. We do not leave our Christian principles at the door on entry! Please be aware that there is an infra-red CCTV in operation inside and outside the premises permanently recording for added security. The Club is there for the benefit of all registered parishioners who are members, to socialise together. The facility exists because there is a church that meets to celebrate weekly at Mass. It is particular disturbing when some parishioners are reported to be regularly seen in the bar/club for various social gatherings but permanently absent from church attendance here on Sundays. It is this kind of behaviour that has led this Diocese and neighbouring Dioceses to take the decision to permanently close similar Club/Bars, and be under no illusion our Club/Bar is very much under intense scrutiny at the moment. If we are shut down, it will be the result of a misplaced focus and the irresponsible actions of a few. It's yours to lose or keep.
