Even now, almost two thousand years after the finding of that empty tomb, the challenge is still there to us to respond with faith or with incredulity. To the Church in its early years belief in the reality of the Resurrection was almost coterminous with faith itself: if one were to come to belief in the Resurrection of Christ from the dead, then all the rest followed. And really, it is the same for us. Where people have denied the true nature of Christ's resurrection, then disbelief in his divinity is not so far behind, for this ability to lay down his own life and take it up again implies a power over death and life far beyond that of the ordinary mortal, however talented, or holy.

The Resurrection of our Lord from the dead is not just a sort of impressive display to convince us of the truth of his teachings (as so many of his miracles were), but to give us hope that, in this world which so often appears hopeless, there is healing, there is a future and there will be restoration where now all seems to be decay. The decline of our faculties as we grow ill or aged is only a temporary thing: we have already died with Christ in baptism; the true life we now have is hidden in Christ with God, and, just as God raised Jesus from the dead, so he will raise our frail mortal bodies, transformed into copies of his glorious body. Thanks be to

God, who has given us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ! Christ is risen, Alleluia!
