# "Near restful waters you lead me"

It's a parent's job to see that his or her child have the tools they need to do well in life. They oversee that they read and write or cook and clean. But are the children being taught how to be productively quiet? I'm not talking here that "children be seen and not heard" theory. I'm talking about nurturing in the children the ability to be still so that they begin to be attuned to truths they can only come to know inwardly - such as, who they really are. The importance of quiet time is not something our present culture respects. There is an overemphasis on competition and social interaction which leads you as the parent to overschedule the children's diary. As a result the children fear silence and solitude. We see this very much with teenagers who cannot even do homework without having



background music of some sort on. By filling the children's daily schedule with constant activity there is a danger that they can also get distracted from hearing their inner voices and the inner voice of God. The child whose private quiet time is respected and protected benefits in many ways. They are offered the opportunity to develop their own individuality and sense of self, to follow their own creative passions and to develop their imagination. Quiet time is a very good preparation for prayer and for the celebration of Mass on Sundays. Quiet time offers the child to develop in body, mind and soul. Sometimes parents feel uneasy when the children are not active or making noise. But that's just as bad for the soul as a daily diet of pizza might be for the body. If you ask your child "what are you doing? And they reply "nothing", this is exactly what the child's soul might be craving for - a period of inactivity. Perhaps, as the parent, doing "nothing" might also be what your own soul is craving for so rather than intervening, follow instead your child's lead.


