## DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO LOURDES 25th July - 2nd August



Each year the Diocese organises a pilgrimage lead by the Bishop to the shrine of Our Lady in Lourdes in the south of France. About 800 people join the pilgrimage, including doctors, nurses, chaplains some 250 helpers (mainly young people) and - the most important pilgrims - about 250 sick and disabled people.

The pilgrimage is meant to be for all who join it a spiritual journey focussed on serving each other, especially serving the sick. It is also a time of joy and fun.

For the past few years the Redshirts have been an important part of the annual diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes.

The Redshirts are officially known as the Lourdes Youth Service Group, but they are nicknamed 'the redshirts' for reasons which aren't too difficult to figure out.

The role of the Redshirts is to provide a welcome at the Masses and other events of the pilgrimage and to serve people in many other ways. Those that have been on this pilgrimage as "Redshirts" return full of joy and determination to return again the following year. A couple who met as Redshirts there, are getting married here in August.
