Weekday 25 Year II Morning Prayer Psalter Week 1

My very dear friends (at least that is what I am sure you will become!),

Well, here we are at the start of a new chapter in my life and in the life of this parish. I am immensely grateful to all those both here in Caterham and also in the Adur Valley, my last parish, who have helped with my transition.

This is always a stressful time in a priest's life; as Fr Kieran commented a week or two ago, when you have lived for several years in a parish, you make friends and connections which are painful to break. The comfort lies in making lots of new friends and connections, of course.

This week is a significant one for me. On Wednesday 24th, I will celebrate the twenty-fifth anniversary of my ordination to the priesthood. This is normally a time for big celebrations, but of course, there is not even a scheduled Mass here on Wednesday, nor has there been time to arrange anything. So I hope that you will not mind if, like the Queen's birthday, I defer the celebration to another day. I propose 12th June, next year, the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, patronal feast of the parish. It's a bit odd to defer it that long, but it'll give us all a chance to get to know one another and then we can really party. So on Wednesday, I am going to say Mass quietly with the students and staff at St John's Seminary early in the morning.

The seminary is an important part of my work; you will be aware that with the decline in vocations priests are having to double up jobs. So each week during term time I will need to go to the seminary on Thursday evenings to be ready to teach on Friday morning. I will then return to the parish by the early afternoon. This too is the reason that the morning Mass on Fridays will need to move to the evening. I had intended that this would start this week, but I was made aware of a really important event: on Friday Patrick and Angela Eade will celebrate their golden wedding anniversary. An important part of that will be the 10.00 Mass which they want to share with you all. So the Friday Mass will move to the evening from next week.

This gives me the opportunity to welcome to the parish a brother priest, Fr Gerry Devlin, of the Motherwell Diocese in Scotland, who has been appointed chaplain at Woldingham School. He has kindly agreed to celebrate the Mass on Friday for Patrick and Angela, so you will have a chance to meet him. I do hope that he will become a real friend and important part of this parish.

I must ask for your patience over the next few weeks, please: any new priest coming into a parish as lively as this one will need some time to get the hang of things, and there will almost be teething problems. But, please God, all will be fine soon.

Above all, please pray for me as I begin my ministry among you. God bless you all.

Some reminders about Children's Liturgy (running Term time only)

Liturgy for younger children aged 1 -

I - Only one adult per family should accompany the children to the liturgy.

I - There will be a collection at every session.

I - Your seat in the Church can be reserved by picking up a sign from the table with the Hosts on.

- Every 2nd Sunday of the month at 10.30 Mass the 1-14's will be asked to come up to the altar during the 1 final hymn and given instruments to shake.

I Liturgy for the Older Children from Reception age 5 - the I end of Year 3

- Children who have made their First Holy Communion should remain in the Mass. If parents really feel their child will benefit from attending the session please mention this to the Liturgist before Mass.

- Please ensure your child does not bring anything other than themselves through to the hall.

I - Every 2nd Sunday of the Month at 10.30 there will be a Youth Mass instead of an Older Children's Liturgy. The children will do the roles of Welcoming, Offertory, Reading / Bidding prayers and choir at these Masses.

I - All children who have made their First Communion volunteer to become Altar Servers if they wish to or can join the Children's Choir.
