Vatican IIcontinued from last week.

During the Council, however, extraordinary consensus emerged around the 16 documents voted. Dissent was restricted to a small group of arch-conservatives, including French Archbishop Marcel Lefebvre, who established the Society of St. Pius X in 1970 and was excommunicated in 1988 along with four bishops he ordained. The Council changed the language of the mass from Latin to the vernacular. It defined the church as the whole "people of God," rather than an institutional hierarchy. It described lay people, for the first

time, as part of the church's structure and crucial to its survival. It enshrined the principle of "collegiality," which suggested a decentralization of power.

The Council also paved the way for historic talks with other religions by implying that salvation can be found outside of the Roman Catholic Church. It lifted the charge of deicide against the Jews and firmly deplored "displays of anti-Semitism."

Finally, it set the stage for a church more engaged in social justice. It denounced war and called for the change of economic systems that benefit the few and leave many in squalor. It's a stretch to see the Council's reforms as radical. But much was done in the name of "the spirit of Vatican II" - a notion fuelled by progressive social winds of the time.

There will be a special blessing by Fr Kieran on Sunday 10th November at 6.30 pm. All welcome to attend. This huge task is now complete. Also, thanks to the scouts, beavers and cubs who attended and completely rejuvenated the outside of the church, clearing all the weeds and debris. They did a fantastic job, working in the rain for the most part of the day! Last week we fitted out the storage room with racking on which to store the food. We still urgently need lots more food so please keep bringing items in. Remember, we need tinned meat and fish, tinned veg, tinned fruit, coffee/tea, pasta, rice, noodles, pasta sauces, UHT milk, cartons of fruit juice, biscuits, cereal, tinned and powdered soup, sugar, jams and spreads. We need anything non perishable with a good shelf life, we do not take fresh or dairy goods.
