Gospel Reflection

In today's Gospel we read of one of those 'handing-over' moments, when our Lord prepares for his departure by commissioning his followers to carry on the same work he had been doing. You will remember that St Paul likens the Church to our Lord's bodyindeed we read something of this in today's second reading-and St Paul must have drawn this teaching from incidents like that recalled in today's Gospel. Only God can forgive sins—an offence against God—the Pharisees knew this well, which is why they were scandalized when our Lord did so. Today we hear of something even more scandalous; our Lord gives his apostles that same power, so that as far as forgiving sins goes, we still have the same opportunity as did those who begged the Lord's forgiveness in person. So, to those who would wish that our Lord were still with us, had never ascended into heaven, there is more than a little truth in saying that in fact our Lord has never left us, I will not leave you orphans (Jn:18); he is still here in all vital ways in his Church. He continues to teach, to heal, to correct error, to love, to console, to forgive, to feed, just as he did two thousand years ago, only now it is not in his physical body, but in his mystical body, the Church. It is important to say here that this does not only apply to the Church's hierarchy, but applies to all the baptized who are members of his body. Our Lord taught with his tongue and healed with his hands, so we must not expect that all members of his mystical body the Church will have the same function. The apostles and their successors forgive sins (as we read in today's Gospel), but all of us are called to show the love of Christ to our neighbours, and in doing so it is well to recall that we are perpetuating the presence of Christ on earth in the power of the Holy Spirit who is given to us precisely that we may do just that.
