### New Parish Development and Restoration Project 2017:

The time is soon approaching when I will be appealing to your generosity for the conservation and restoration of the Tapestry stencilling effect (art work) that surrounds the Sanctuary, at the back of the Altar and also to restore the original Tapestry stencilled drawings that surrounded the Lady Chapel, which was white-washed over in the 1950's. The Lady Chapel consisted of stencilled floral pattern of repeating crowned floral motifs and beads alternating diagonally with crosses, in some way typifying the Rosary. By all accounts, it was very beautiful to behold. These wall paintings were done by Joseph Aloysius Pippet between 1890-1892. At the same time I would like to install a permanent stone altar with matching ambo and Presidential chair befitting the architectural style of the church in-line with the exhortations of the Second Vatican Council and which was left unfinished when the re-ordering the Sanctuary took place some years ago. The Squash Court is also dilapidating and needs some thought as to its future purpose. We cannot delay any further, as the existing drawings are starting to decay quite rapidly, as you can see through closer observation. An estimated cost for the entire project would be around **£350,000**. With this in mind, I would like to draw up a Committee to help me steer this through from planning to implementation, to completion, to work alongside the Parish Finance Committee. The project will be governed by a local Conservationist Architect but I also need people skilled in Fund Raising particularly, and any other aspects that may help us achieve our goal. It's hoped to have this finished inside the next 5 years. If you feel you would like to be part of this historic restoration work, please come to a preliminary meeting on Wednesday 17th October at 8.00 pm in the Old Hall for a short background presentation led by Deirdre Waddington and air your views.
