SAINT OSCAR ROMERO - "A VOICE FOR THE VOICELESS"

On Sunday, 14 October 2018 Archbishop Oscar Romero, was proclaimed a Saint along with Pope Paul VI and 5 others. Many parishioners will remember the inspiring performance of 'Romero – Heartbeat of El Salvador' by the Christian theatre company RISE Theatre, and hosted by the Parish last year. It told the true story of Oscar Romero and his heart for the oppressed people of

El Salvador. He chose to challenge those in power and stand up for social justice and demanded respect for human rights and was assassinated whilst saying Mass on March 24th 1980. Two national events are being held to celebrate his canonization: Saturday, 3 November at 12.30pm Mass of Thanksgiving St George's Cathedral, Southwark, Principal celebrant: Archbishop Peter Smith; Homily: Archbishop Bernard
