MADABA LUNCH SUN 18TH NOV

75 parishioners and friends enjoyed a popular lunch last Sunday. Thanks to all who attended or helped in any way with arrangements. £650 was raised from the sale of tickets, the raffle and donations.

Fr Firas, the new parish priest in Madaba, has 8000 parishioners. This figure includes 600 refugees from Iraq. He has requested that we fund 120 frozen chickens to ensure that his poorest parishioners get meat at Christmas. The school has also requested help with the cost of sweaters and coats for the poorest children. Jordanian winters are shorter than ours but can be very cold. The funds we have in hand will cover these costs.

The refugees greatly value Christmas and Easter greetings. Cards will be available after Sunday Mass for the next 2 weeks. Please sign one and send a goodwill message to a refugee family.

THE WORLD DAY FOR THE POOR

Pope Francis has asked that the Catholic Church set aside one day a year when we 'reflect on how poverty is at the heart of the Gospel'. This is The World Day for the Poor.

5 ways to observe World Day for the Poor

- 1) PRAY FOR THE POOR. eg use the headlines. As you see headlines about what is happening around the World, pause and pray for the people involved.
- 2) LEARN ABOUT POVERTY AND WORK FOR CHANGE. eg climate change, war, lack of jobs. Speak on behalf of those in need by sending letters to your MP. Tell others what you have learnt.
- 3) SUPPORT THE CHURCH WORK FOR THE POOR. eg CAFOD, The Children's Society, Parish- es for Peace
- 4) MAKE CARING FOR THE POOR PART OF THE WAY YOU LIVE. eg buy fairly traded tea, coffee, bananas etc. Consider buying world gifts from CAFOD or SVP as Christmas gifts.
- 5) PRACTICE THE CORPORAL WORKS OF MERCY. These are Jess teachings - feed the hungry, shelter the homeless, visit the sick, and imprisoned, give alms to the poor and care for God's creation.
