On Sunday, 14 October 2018 Archbishop Oscar Romero, was proclaimed a Saint along with Pope Paul VI and 5 others. Many parishioners will remember the inspiring performance of 'Romero - Heartbeat of El Salvador' by the Christian theatre company RISE Theatre, and hosted by the Parish last year. It told the true story of Oscar Romero and his heart for the oppressed people of

El Salvador. He chose to challenge those in power and stand up for social justice and demanded respect for human rights and was assassinated whilst saying Mass on March 24th 1980. Two national events are being held to celebrate his canonization: Saturday, 3 November at 12.30pm Mass of Thanksgiving St George's Cathedral, Southwark, Principal celebrant: Archbishop Peter Smith; Homily: Archbishop Bernard



Our monthly Parish Youth Club (for 7-11-year-olds) needs a new co-ordinating team.

If volunteers come forward now, they can work with the current team who are stepping down next summer to concentrate on building a programme for the growing monthly Parish Chill Club for older children (aged 11-15), which they also run.

The existing co-ordinators have established a replicable 4-year programme of exciting activities and an email database to make the handover of Youth Club as easy as possible.
