PRIVATE PRAYER

We are pleased to announce that our Church will be open for private prayer, weekly for two hours, three times a week. Private Prayer opening times:

Wednesday 2pm to 4pm (2pm to 3pm vulnerable parishioners only)

Friday 2pm to 4pm

Sunday 2pm to 4pm

We will open on Wednesdays between 2pm and 3pm for our most vulnerable parishioners only (those who have been strictly shielding and have had to have shopping brought to them) and between 3pm and 4pm for all parishioners. We ask at this early stage that if possible, we limit to adults only.

We will be exercising social distancing and will limit the number of parishioners inside the Church at one time, you may need to queue outside. You will also be asked to use the hand sanitising gels provided on entry. Stewards will be on hand to help and direct parishioners please note that should you wish to light a candle, a steward will need to do this for you as part of our safety measures.

Please note that the Church is only open for personal private prayer, you will not be able to attend Mass or group rosary sessions. The Church will remain locked outside of the times noted above until further notice.
