Books are checked for suitability, for instance books on English history are not relevant to a Zulu child. The Black Lives Matter movement has encouraged a closer look at children's encyclopaedias. Books published as recently as the 1980s show Africa as being 'discovered' by Europeans with no mention of the peoples or cultures which exist in this vast continent, which is almost 50 times larger than the UK.





In an ideal world our donated books would not be needed in an African classroom or school library. Meanwhile in KwaZuluNatal most children are still taught in English but limited availability, high prices and lack of

funds mean they are unable to buy books in English or their first language, IsiZulu.
