CHURCH OPENING AND CHRISTMAS MASS PROPOSAL

It is with great sadness and disappointment that in light of the high number of COVID-19 cases in Caterham, the church will not be open for private prayer until at least the end of lockdown. The recent positive case in our Parish, not only highlighted some weakness in our already strict procedures, but has also meant that a number of stewards have stepped down. We hope that the church can be opened for private prayer once the second lockdown has been lifted or eased.

With regards to Mass, we are currently reviewing the procedures we have already set out and are looking at how we can further improve the safety for everyone attending and stewarding Mass. On the whole if everyone follows guidance we can make this work.

The question on everyone's mind is what is the plan for our Christmas celebration. We are currently considering all aspects for the safest and fairest way to celebrate Christmas Mass this year. We have a number of considerations; allocations of seats with maximum social distance; the logistics of a booking system; the possible use of halls; steward availability, as well as the availability for people to clean between Masses. Each and every consideration has a number of issue/hurdles to overcome such as Diocesan sign off to open up halls and having enough stewards to man both the church and the hall etc.

Currently the safest proposal is to close the church for Christmas Masses and stream it online only. Once Mass has ended a short break is proposed to allow people to arrive at church to receive Holy Communion only, again this will need to be stewarded. It is by no means anyone's preference, however it seems to be the fairest and safest way. We are reviewing the situation regularly, and if the situation improves, this proposal will be rethought. Any updates or proposals will be detailed in coming newsletters.

Presented by CaFE Director David Payne, these four enjoyable sessions will help you to face the challenges of everyday life with renewed hope and joy.


