You can join the group at any point it is not necessary to attend all the meetings. Details of the course can be sent to you if you are unable to join in.



CHURCH OPENING AND CHRISTMAS MASS PROPOSAL

We are pleased to announce that the Church will reopen from Sunday 6th December for public Masses. After this date, the church will open for public Mass on Tuesdays at 10am and Saturdays at 10am as well as Sundays. Other weekday Masses will still be celebrated online but closed to the public.

If you have not already done so, we ask that anyone wishing to attend Mass obtains a unique track and trace number from the parish office at <u>info@sacred-heart.co.uk</u> before arriving at church. It will not be possible to register on the day. Everyone will need to ensure that they cover their nose and mouth while inside the church at all times. We appreciate that some may not be able to wear a face covering and would ask people affected to consider joining Mass online instead.

On arrival, you will be asked for your unique track and trace number, you will have your temperature taken and you will need to sanitise your hands before being seated. A steward will seat you in allocated spaces and we ask that you sit exactly where you are shown (do not move along the pew). You will be directed when to go for Holy Communion, then again at the end of Mass. Please remain in your seat until you are instructed.

When moving through the church please always adhere to the two metre distance rule. We also ask that when you are directed to exit the church, you leave immediately and do not congregate in the porch. There will be an opportunity to leave your weekly offering in a basket near the font (please have it ready before you stand to leave) or to use the contactless machines on leaving. Clearly marked Sunday offerings can also be put through the office door at any time.

There will not be a booking system and parishioners will still be able to attend Mass on a first come, first served basis. We apologise in advance if you are not able to attend Mass if the church is full.

There will be a booking system for Christmas Masses and the details of how you can book will be given in the newsletter shortly.

We thank our stewards for their continued help and we ask that parishioners remain respectful of the stewards and follow their directions exactly. We are grateful for your patience and co-operation in this matter. If we all follow the guidance, we will be able to celebrate Masses together safely.

In summary for the Safety of all parishioners:

- · Unique track and trace household number required for admission to the church
- · Noses and mouths to be covered before entry
- · Temperatures to be taken before entry
- · Everyone to sanitise hands immediately after entry
- · 2 metre distance from all other parishioners to be maintained
- The directions of our stewards to be followed at all times
