Fr Firas Nasrawin, the parish priest, is setting up a small committee representing both communities to arrange the purchase, packing and distribution of the food boxes in time for Christmas. He has already promised to send us a list of recipients, a short report and photographs. These will be published in the newsletter when they arrive. CHURCH OPENING

The Church will now be open from 6th December for public Masses on Tuesdays at 10am, Saturdays at 10am and Sundays. Other weekday Masses will still be celebrated online but closed to the public.

If you have not already done so, we ask that anyone wishing to attend Mass obtains a unique track and trace number from the parish office at <u>info@sacred-heart.co.uk</u> before arriving at church. It will not be possible to register on the day. Although we have a government QR code this is not sufficient for parish entry. Everyone will need to ensure that they cover their nose and mouth while inside the church at all times. We appreciate that some may not be able to wear a face covering and would ask people affected to consider joining Mass online instead.

On arrival, you will be asked for your unique track and trace number, you will have your temperature taken and you will need to sanitise your hands before being seated. A steward will seat you in allocated spaces and we ask that you sit exactly where you are shown (do not move along the pew). You will be directed when to go for Holy Communion, then again at the end of Mass. Please remain in your seat until you are instructed.

When moving through the church please always adhere to the two metre distance rule. We also ask that when you are directed to exit the church, you leave immediately and do not congregate in the porch. There will be an opportunity to leave your weekly offering in a basket near the font (please have it ready before you stand to leave) or to use the contactless machines on leaving. Clearly marked Sunday offerings can also be put through the office door at any time.

There will not be a booking system for regular Masses and parishioners will still be able to attend Mass on a first come, first served basis. We apologise in advance if you are not able to attend Mass if the church is full.

We thank our stewards for their continued help and we ask that parishioners remain respectful of the stewards and follow their directions exactly. We are grateful for your patience and co-operation in this matter. If we all follow the guidance, we will be able to celebrate Masses together safely.

In summary for the Safety of all parishioners:

- Unique track and trace household number required for admission to the church
 - Noses and mouths to be covered before entry
 - Temperatures to be taken before entry
 - Everyone to sanitise hands immediately after entry
 - 2 metre distance from all other parishioners to be maintained
 - The directions of our stewards to be followed at all times

On the days where there is no public Mass, Fr Seán would like to invite the donor of Mass intentions to attend Mass on their own (max 6 in the same household/bubble). Please contact the office if you would like to attend Mass for your intention so that arrangements can be made for access.

We kindly ask that you do not leave Christmas cards in the porch for collection by others.

Finally, we are restricting visitors to the parish office and presbytery, to this end we ask that school form for schools other than St Francis, are posted through the parish office door. Fr Seán will sign and return the form directly to the school in question. Please ensure that **copies** of baptism certificates are included. If you are applying to St Francis, the whole form should be submitted to the school where Fr Seán will sign them all together.

We are very happy to announce that, with Canon Jim's assistance, there will have five Christmas Masses. Christmas Vigil 7pm, 9pm, Midnight, Christmas morning 9am and 10:45am. We invite those already registered for parish track & trace to request a place via our booking email <u>bookings@sacred-heart.co.uk</u>. Those who have not registered for parish track & trace will be able to request seats from 13th December. Please note that seats will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. Please give your name and the names of the people within your household/bubble who will attend. Please note that we can only allow one pew per household/bubble. Please provide your parish track & trace number and your 1st and 2nd choice of Mass time. Please note that by sending an email, this does not guarantee a place. You will be contacted with your seating allocation along with further details shortly afterwards. We apologise in advance if we are not able to accommodate you.
