Fr Firas was very impressed by the warm welcome he received from Fr Sean and the Sacred Heart parishioners during his recent visit.

He wrote, 'I extend my thanks and love to you all. You left a beautiful mark in my heart.'

Thank you to all who helped to look after Fr. Firas during his stay especially those who helped in so many ways with the parish lunch which raised over £800.

A big thank you for all the wonderful desserts donated and enjoyed at the lunch. If you were one of the very kind people who laundered a tablecloth please return them as soon as you can. You can leave them in the shop.

There were also generous contributions of £1057 to the collections after each Mass on 22nd May.

On Wednesday 25th May Fr Firas spoke to over 50 Catenians and their wives at the annual Tandridge Circle dinner for local clergy. He talked about the history and present situation of his parish. He is especially concerned about the emigration of Christians from Madaba due to lack of jobs. A raffle at the event raised £276 for Madaba.

All funds will be donated to Fr Firas' projects to create opportunities for his parishioners. More about this in future weeks.
