### BIKES FOR UKRAINE

Transport is a major issue for many Ukrainian families coming to this area, as it has been for other asylum groups before them. Local charities are regularly agreeing funding for transport for children to school (while we wait on the local authority education team to award funding) and for adults to access the DWP specified English Language classes in Croydon and Redhill, which they need to attend to as part of the access to benefits / work.

To work well this bike scheme needs bikes donated so they can be refurbished and then distributed. I wonder how many bikes are gathering dust in garages and sheds? Is it time they found a new home and help someone along the way?

Residents or organisations can also support this initiative by taking any old/unwanted bikes along to their local Community Recycling Centre (<https://www.surreycc.gov.uk/waste-and-recycling/community-recycling-centres>) – bikes donated up until the end of July will be recycled and given to support Ukrainian refugees or other local good causes (including refugees from Afghanistan/Syria and other places)
