UKRAINIAN SUPPORT GROUP

Following the Caterham Ukrainians Support Group - team meeting yesterday here is other information to share with guests and hosts, or members of the congregation supporting local Ukrainian initiatives.

The Arc is making their Ukrainian Pizza Evening a regular event after the launch (which is on the only flyer I can find). The next event is Thursday 21 July. It is a child friendly event, has access to the soft play area and has an area where adults without children can sit and eat in peace. Open to hosts and guests living in the Tandridge area. The evenings so far are very well attended so booking is essential. There is transport if needed. Also the opportunity to join the Caterham Supports Ukraine WhatsApp group which allows guests and hotes to keep in touch.

Soper Hall – weekly coffee mornings are family friendly and open to hosts and guests from across Tandridge. Take place on Wednesday between 10/12noon and is open to anyone from the Tandridge area and those in the neighbouring Croydon postcodes – Kenley, Old Coulsdon etc.

For those living in London borough of Croydon – Croydon Salvation Army are providing English as a second language courses.
