THE JUSTICE AND PEACE GROUP

The Justice and Peace group invites you to join in a short Peace Rosary after 7pm Mass on Friday 5th August (in person or online <https://www.church-services.tv/caterham>). This month we remember the devastation caused in Hiroshima and Nagasaki when the atomic bombs were dropped, on 6 and 9 August 1945, and in our unstable world, we pray that nuclear weapons will be abolished so that they can never be used again.

In his message, 'A Culture of Care as a Path to Peace' 2021, Pope Francis asks, 'How many resources are spent on weaponry, especially nuclear weapons, that could be used for more significant priorities such as ensuring the safety of individuals, the promotion of peace and integral human development, the fight against poverty, and the provision of health care'. Pope Francis calls on us to 'strive daily, in concrete and practical ways, to form a community composed of brothers and sisters who accept and care for one another'.
