Each Christmas and Easter we send a contribution to fund food parcels for the Iraqi refugees and poor Jordanian parishioners in Madaba.

We all know that the UK economy is in difficulties but one result of this can go unnoticed. When we began supporting Madaba each £ was worth a Jordanian Dinar. Now each £ buys only 0.75 Dinar. Our recent contributions for food parcels have been around £4000 each time. To supply the same value per parcel we now need £ 5000. Please keep this in mind as we begin to seek donations for this very worthy cause.
