Taxpayers who are not in the parish scheme can simply use one of the gift aid envelopes in the church porch and put their name and address on it. Make sure you write MADABA on the envelope so that your donation goes to the right place

You can also use one of the contactless machines (Select gift aid) Remember to let the parish office know about your donation.

APOSTOLATE OF EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

The main purpose of the Apostolate is to enable and encourage our parishioners to become more actively involved in praying for vocations to the priesthood and religious life, focussing especially on their local community. We are being asked to pray for their own clergy, for God's blessing on their ministry, and for the conversion of their parish. The Apostolate hinges on personal commitment: Individuals are being asked to pledge themselves to an hour's Adoration every week at a set time on a set day. They become part of a Team, you could say, rather like a runner passing on the baton in a relay race.

While everyone is most welcome to take part, those who make a regular weekly commitment are the backbone of the Apostolate.

With this in mind, Brendan Cleary, the UK Director, will lead a day of Recollection and Instruction on Saturday 5th November at St Michael's Worthing. The day will begin with Mass, celebrated by Bishop Richard, and end about mid-afternoon.
