### **COP 27 FILM FESTIVAL THE LETTER - MON 14TH NOV**

The Letter is a documentary film about the Pope's landmark Laudato si' environmental encyclical. It encourages us to see how 'everything is connected' and interweaves the lives of five main characters: an Amazon rain forest tribe chief; a young climate activist from India; a Senegalese climate refugee student studying sustainable development; and U.S. scientists who have developed an innovative technique to map underwater heatwaves that kill coral reefs.
