MADABA: THE SCOUTS

On the outskirts of Madaba on a site next to the Catholic boys secondary school Fr Firas has developed a facility which will accommodate up to 100 scouts or other youth groups. Over 18 units each able to sleep at least 4 people are available so far. They were originally provided for Iraqi refugees who are now living in the town or have obtained visas to live elsewhere. Fr Samuel, an Italian assistant priest, is the spiritual guide of the scouts in Madaba. He is keen to see the site development completed and in regular use:

'We need to work constantly to finish it. We hope to improve the camp and make it more welcoming. We hope it will become a reference point for scouts throughout Jordan. We humbly ask for God's help and yours so that we can slowly make this a reality. The many requests from people beyond our parish to host groups are an encouragement from the Lord to pursue this project.'

In the next few days we hope to provide more details and photographs in the church porch about the scout project.
