SJOG HOMES FOR UKRAINE

We would like your support for individuals displaced by the war in Ukraine. Our Catholic charity, St John of God Hospitaller Services (SJOG), together with our partners Caritas Social Action Network (CSAN) is currently running a Homes for Ukraine programme, which provides temporary housing and support for Ukrainian displaced individuals as they adjust to life in the UK.

Our purpose is to evacuate people from the warzone and prevent homelessness amongst those Ukrainians already in the UK. The programme has received funding from The Albert Gubay Foundation and the Department for Levelling up, Housing and Communities.
