### PEACE SUNDAY

Next Sunday, 15 January, is PEACE SUNDAY and this year the message from Pope Francis tells us: 'No one can be saved alone. Combating Covid-19 together, embarking together on paths of peace'.

He asks us: 'What did we learn from the pandemic? What new paths should we follow to cast off the shackles of our old habits, to be better prepared, to dare new things? What signs of life and hope can we see, to help us move forward and try to make our world a better place?'

A vaccine has been found for Covid-19, says the Holy Father, but we still need to tackle the virus of war, and of inequality, and this can only be done together.

In this country we have an active Catholic peace movement in Pax Christi, which aims at working together to promote peace through parishes, schools and social media.

### MADABA: THE SCOUTS

On the outskirts of Madaba on a site next to the Catholic boys secondary school Fr Firas has developed a facility which will accommodate up to 100 scouts or other youth groups. Over 18 units each able to sleep at lest 4 people are available so far. They were originally provided for Iraqi refugees who are now living in the town or have obtained visas to live elsewhere. Fr Samuel, an Italian assistant priest, is the spiritual guide of the scouts in Madaba. He is keen to see the site development completed and in regular use:

'We need to work constantly to finish it. We hope to improve the camp and make it more welcoming. We hope it will become a reference point for scouts throughout Jordan. We humbly ask for God's help and yours so that we can slowly make this a reality. The many requests from people beyond our parish to host groups are an encouragement from the Lord to pursue this project.'
