#### FUNDANAMI TRUST

Mass at 10:45am on Sunday 26th Feb will be offered for the intentions of all who contributed to Eliz & Mike Wood's charity established to improve literacy in parts of KwaZuluNatal in South Africa. It was recently closed.

Parishioners and Tandridge Catenians were among those who contributed cash and children's books to open and enhance school libraries in the Kwadukuza area near the Indian Ocean coast. In the 10yrs preceding Covid 170,000 new and used books were shipped in containers to Durban and distributed to schools. 5 anthologies of local children's writing were published and a secondary school library and resource centre was built and equipped with books and computers.

Children's books are still desperately needed in African countries and the charity Books4Africa based near Canterbury collects and distributes thousands every year. Their website gives details. We have recently delivered 10,000 books from Caterham. If you have children's books you are happy to part with, they may be left in plastic bags or small boxes at the Sacred Heart shop on Sunday 26th February and they will be delivered to Canterbury.
