REQUEST FOR PILGRIMAGE HELPERS

Applications from pilgrims requiring assistance to journey with the Diocese Pilgrimage to Lourdes this summer are back to pre-Covid numbers – which is wonderful news, but it does mean we now need lots of helpers, nurses and HCAs to apply to make sure we have enough people to care for them in Lourdes.

Further information and a link to the application is available on the Lourdes Pilgrimage (abdiocese.org.uk) website.

The diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes takes place 28 July to 3 August for those travelling by air, or 27 July to 4 August for those travelling by coach or jumble. The cost for Helpers and Clinicians is £680 (subsidised) or £850 full price. There are further subsidies which may be available.
