Welcome to Homes for Ukraine webinar – Wednesday 28 June 2023 7.30pm
During this online presentation "Welcome to Homes for Ukraine", you will learn about SJOG Hospitaller Services, their Projects and History. You will have a chance to learn about SJOG "Homes for Ukraine" matching service, as well as who is eligible to be sponsored, and a typical portrait of a Ukrainian displaced individual you might expect to host. We will discuss some key considerations before deciding to host, the hosting process itself (including checks by your local authorities, DBS checks, and preparing your property), and your role as a host (including what is not expected of you). By participating in SJOG Homes for Ukraine, you can provide a safe and supportive environment for Ukrainian families in need and help them integrate into our community in the UK.
