CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

We will be starting the Children's Liturgy of The Word from Sunday 11th June. It will be every Sunday during school term time and will take place in the Canon Roe Hall (Old Hall) during the 10.45am Mass service only. It is open to children currently in Reception up to Year 3 primary school. This will allow the children to celebrate Mass in the same way as the adults do in church, but it will be carried out in a fun and engaging way that is age appropriate. It will be run by DBS certified volunteers and parents are encouraged to drop their child off with the group before Mass & collect at the end of Mass. For safeguarding reasons, we cannot accept children who have not been pre-registered and numbers will be limited to observe strict child to adult ratios in line with Diocese guidance.
