**Celebrating the Feast of St Joachim and St Anne – Saturday 22 July 2.30pm at Arundel Cathedral**

Pope Francis has offered his thoughts on the Feast of St Joachim and Anne. He says "I would invite you to make a concrete gesture that would include grandparents and the elderly. Let us not abandon them. Their presence in families and communities is a precious one, for it reminds us that we share the same heritage and are part of a people committed to preserving its roots. From the elderly we received the gift of belonging to God's holy people. The Church, as well as society, needs them, for they entrust to the present the past that is needed to build the future. Let us honour them, neither depriving ourselves of their company nor depriving them of ours. The World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly is meant to be a small but precious sign of hope for them and for the whole Church."

As a Diocese we will celebrate this day with Mass followed by refreshments afterwards in the cathedral centre. Please come with the older generation to celebrate the gift of their presence in your family and in your parish.
