The really shocking result of a recent poll of Catholics showed that two-thirds (nearly 70%) of Catholics thought that the consecrated bread and wine were only symbols of the Body and Blood of Christ.

CAFOD "SEEDS FOR ALL" CAMPAIGN

Over the next 2 weeks we have an opportunity to show our solidarity with our brothers and sisters who are small farmers in devel-

oping nations. Multi-national agricultural seed suppliers pressurise governments to enact legislation and develop policies restricting small farmers access to a range of seeds. This means small farmers are under pressure to abandon a range of seeds that generations have developed for resilient and productive crops specific to those regions of the world with assistance from aid agencies this parish has supported over the last 60+ years. Salina a small farmer in Bangladesh with Cafod is inviting you to sign a letter to the President of The World Bank:

1. To protect fundamental rights of small farmers to save, use, exchange & sell their own variety of seeds.

2 To put an end to policies that limit the access & choice small farmers have over seeds.

There will be a letter to sign as you leave after Mass today. No contact details or money is required. These letters will be displayed over the next 14 days in the porch if you are in a rush. On Sunday members of Justice & Peace Group & Cafod will be at hand if you want more information. Thank you
