WHAT HAPPENED AT THE OCTOBER SYNOD

Austen Ivereigh is coming to talk to St Joseph's Church on Friday 10 November 7:30 pm to talk about what happened at the October 2023 Synod in Rome – and why it matters to us all. Austen Ivereigh, the papal biographer, and a well-known writer and speaker on Catholic affairs, is in the synod as part of a team of “expert theologians” helping with the process. He will explain why this has been a synod like no other: who was there, how it worked, and how it is set to change the Church in surprising ways. He is an exceptional speaker who is interesting, amusing, and easy to listen to. You won't be disappointed. As always, he is open to questions from the floor.

The Synod of Bishops taking place in Rome, the first of two concluding the three-year “synod on synodality”, is the most important event since the Second Vatican Council. It is set to transform the culture of the Catholic Church by recovering a way of “walking together” that is as old as the Church itself.

Austen known for his two biographies of Pope Francis, and a New York Times bestselling book written in collaboration with him: *Let Us Dream: The Path to a Better Future* (Simon & Schuster, 2020). He is Fellow in Contemporary Church History at the Jesuit-run Campion Hall, University of Oxford, and lives near Hereford.
