SVP COFFEE MORNING

SVP Coffee Morning and Sale in aid of our School Outreach project Sunday 4th February after 9.00am and 10.45am Masses (Centenary Hall)

The SVP has used £1200 to financially support twelve local families in need over the last year, through our School Outreach Project. This help (£100 per family) has been given through our liaison with Family Support Workers in local Primary Schools. The money has been used in a variety of ways: food support, purchase of home essentials, provision of swimming lessons, help with fares etc. In all cases it provides a little extra help to take the pressure off anxious parents who are experiencing a short-term crisis and struggling to manage. We would very much like to continue this important work, but now need to request your support to boost our fundraising! On Sunday 4th February, homemade cakes will be served with tea and coffee in the Centenary Hall, after the two morning Masses. There will also be a sale of knitwear from our Knitting Club and other items. We would be most grateful to any parishioners who would bake cakes to sell for parishioners to take home. (As you know it is now necessary to list ingredients on cakes.) They may be dropped off at the Centenary Hall before the two morning Masses on 4th February, or telephone Biddy (01883 345749) if you would like them to be picked up.
