A special film for Lent - The Way, Martin Sheen plays Tom, an American doctor who comes to France to collect the remains of his adult son, killed in the Pyrenees in a storm while walking The Camino de Santiago. Driven by his profound sadness and desire to understand his lost son, Tom decides to embark on the historical pilgrimage, leaving his California life behind. Armed only with his son's backpack and guidebook, he soon discovers that he won't be alone on this journey - he meets pilgrims from around the world, all looking for greater meaning in their lives. From the hardship experienced along 'The Way' an unlikely group of misfits are bonded and Tom begins to learn the difference between 'the life we live and the life we choose.' 'The Way' was filmed entirely in Spain and France along the actual Camino de Santiago. It was previously shown at Film Club in March 2017!
