Come and learn about 'Refugee Tales':  
Tuesday 30th April at 7.30pm - Canon Roe Hall.  
We will hear from Mary Barrett about Refugee Tales. Rooted in the work of Gatwick Detainees Welfare Group (GDWG), 'Refugee Tales' shares the tales of people held in immigration detention and those who work with them. Our Parish is a regular supporter of the GDWG – this is a great initiative and a chance to learn more about the lives of those it helps.  
Each July 120 walkers per day join Refugee Tales to walk in solidarity with asylum seekers, migrants, and refugees. Every evening of the walk, a social event takes place in the manner of The Canterbury Tales where people with experience of detention share their tales.
