MyDona - IMPORTANT UPDATEWe will shortly install new contact-less payment machines in the Church porch. Along with the new machines the software will also be upgraded, you will then need to re-register your cards again for Gift Aid once they are installed.

If you re-register online you will not have to register again on the new machines.
