LEARN ABOUT ST BENEDICT AT ST AUGUSTINE'S ABBEY, CHILWORTH

St Augustine's Abbey, Chilworth near Guildford invites the public to a Study Morning on Saturday, 18 January 2025, at 10:30 AM. Open to people of all faiths or none, the event will delve into the life and legacy of St Benedict, the Monk, a pivotal figure in the history of Western Christianity.

The session will feature a screening of Bishop Barron's Catholicism: The Pivotal Players video, focusing on St Benedict. Fr John Seddon OSB, a resident Benedictine monk, will lead a discussion after the video. No prior knowledge is required, and participants are welcome to listen without contributing.

St Benedict, born in Italy around 480 AD, lived during a period of cultural decline, similar to challenges faced by society today. He sought to create communities rooted in faith, peace, and discipline, offering a model for Christian living through his Rule of St Benedict. This guide, emphasising humility, prayer, work, and obedience, became the foundation for Western monasticism and helped preserve Christian values through turbulent times.

Benedict's influence extended beyond monastic life. His teachings shaped a new Christian civilisation by fostering communities that balanced spiritual growth with practical service. The video will explore key locations in Benedict's life, such as Subiaco, where he lived as a hermit, and Montecassino, where he founded his most famous monastery.

The morning begins with an optional Holy Roman Catholic Mass at 9:00 AM in the Abbey Church. The main event takes place in the Assisi Room from 10:30 AM to 12:20 PM, with refreshments provided.
