This stunning biographical epic tells the story of Francesca Cabrini, an Italian immigrant, who arrives in New York in 1889, greeted only by disease, crime and impoverished children. Witnessing the vast inequality of the city, she sets off on a daring mission to help society's most vulnerable, but must first overcome the prejudices and indifference of those in power. Despite these momentous

setbacks, her broken English, and poor health, she remains determined to build an empire of hope unlike anything that the world has ever seen. In 1946 Mother Cabrini became the first US citizen to be canonised a saint. She is the patron saint of immigrants. All are welcome and tea/coffee and cake will be served at the interval. The film will finish at about 4.45pm, a little later than usual.

### THE WHITE FATHERS

Next Sunday Fr Hugh Seenan will celebrate Sunday Masses here and will update us on the work of the Missionaries of Africa (The White Fathers).

The Missionaries of Africa a.k.a (The White Fathers), are an international team of priests, brothers and lay associates from Africa, Britain and many counties around the world. The name "White Fathers' comes from their white habit. This was based on the traditional North African dress of a white gown (gandoura) and a white hooded cloak (burnous). A rosary is worn around the neck to show we are men of prayer. Any ministry which has a real relationship with Africa, no matter in what part of the world it may be, considered by the Missionaries of Africa to be within the scope of the apostolate. Through parish work, building up small Christian communities, working with the media, involvement in justice and peace, agriculture, seminary training, education and social welfare the Missionaries of Africa aim to work in partnership with the Church in Africa and above all else to help build up leadership of the Churches.
