My name is Tamanda, and I am a Year 12 student at St Bede's School, and a member of the choir, this Sunday, I'll be holding a bake sale in the Canon Roe Hall, after the morning Masses to raise money for charity.

In July I am accompanying 33 other students from my school on a charity mission trip, organised by the charity Go Make A Difference, to Tanzania! We will be spending 2 weeks away from home - something I've yet to do, so I'm very excited - supporting the Musoma communities by doing lots of mini projects, such as building goat sheds, toilets, houses, and watersheds, and visiting the local school, orphanage and hospital, while learning lots of new things about Tanzanian culture and traditions, in their community and in the church.

All the students going on the trip are aiming to raise £300 each to reach a total of £10,000 between us, which will go towards the less fortunate communities in Tanzania, and buying resources for the building projects we will be doing there.

So I'll be holding a fundraiser bake sale after both the 9am and 10:45 Mass on Sunday the 4th of May in the Canon Roe Hall. So, instead of the usual tea and coffee, I'll be selling a range of different homemade treats, with the help of the SVP, as a fundraiser for my trip and the charity.
