This project is not political or spiritual. Our aim is simple - to sell as many baubles as possible so that we can support our artisans and their families during these exceptionally challenging times.

The glass factories in Hebron have been operating for centuries, carrying on a tradition of remarkable craftsmanship. Glassblowing is hot,

demanding work—especially in the summer months—and it takes incredible skill. Our artisans make it look effortless.

They are proud that most of the materials they use are recycled. Old bottles and window panes are given new life, transformed into beautiful decorations. Because of this, the baubles are a little heavier than typical Christmas ornaments—and strong enough that they'll even bounce on carpet!

Many of the Christian women artisans work from home, hand-painting designs onto the baubles, bells, and peace lights while also caring for their children. In a place where jobs are scarce, this opportunity means a great deal. The income they earn provides vital support for their families. Every bauble sold creates meaningful work and makes a real difference in the lives of both Christian and Muslim communities in Palestine. With your support, they can continue to grow —one bauble at a time.

Pastoral Plan Update

Bishop Richard issued a new Pastoral Plan for the Diocese The Word Who is Life: The Call to Mission in January 2024. The Plan marks an important new stage in the development of diocesan parish structures, with the 11 former deaneries of the Diocese becoming 11 new parishes.

Two new parishes have been established this year; Brighton & Hove (14 September) and Guildford (29 November). Weybridge will be inaugurated on 7 December.
