THE COLUMBAN MISSIONARIES

On Sunday 26th July we will welcome Fr John Boles who will celebrate all 3 Sunday Masses with us and make an appeal for the Columbian Missionaries.

The Columban Missionaries were founded in 1918 as the Irish (or 'Maynooth') Mission to China, where we were given the task of building up (of all places) the Diocese of Wuhan. They worked there for some thirty years before all foreign missionaries were expelled from the country by Mao's government. They then took on poor dioceses and parishes in other countries around the Pacific and in South Asia, such as the Philippines, Korea, Myanmar (Burma), Pakistan, Chile and Peru.

Fr John was born and brought up in Stockport, Greater Manchester and had careers as a Town Planning Officer in the West Midlands and an Overseas Development Officer in Nicaragua, Central America. He joined the Columbians in 1989 and have spent most of his time as a priest in South America, especially in Peru, from whence he returned in 2024 after 27 years of service.
